Luke 1: 26-27 says, *"Now in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin's name was Mary."*

The Father sent His angel Gabriel to this earth to deliver a message to Mary that would change her life. Did you know that He still sends angels to this earth to minister to His people? The Bible says concerning these angels in Hebrews 1:14, *"Are not the angels all ministering spirits (servants) sent out in the service [of God for the assistance] of those who are to inherit salvation?" AMP*

We need to learn to take the limits off of God, and allow Him to minister to us as He wills. Many believers are receiving angelic visitations from the Lord. I know I have had angelic activity in my life, and I expect even more ministry in this way. How about you? Where are you at in your spiritual walk with the Lord? Do you fear tribulations (difficult times), persecution and the uncertainty of the hour we live in? What will happen with your job? Your family? Your life? Do you sense the need for tighter security around you? Do you feel the need for more reassurance of the Lord's faithfulness? If so, you are not alone, many Christians struggle with fear concerning these troubling times during these last days.

How can we overcome these overwhelming feelings of fear and insecurity? One way to calm our hearts is to pray, and not just any prayer, but pray the Word of God.

I believe in the power of praying God's Word over ourselves and our families. Let's begin with Psalm 91 from the NKJV of the Bible.

- Read it several times to familiarize yourself with it.
- After you are familiar with it, start with verse one and personalize it for yourself.
- Meditate upon His protection.
- Start to memorize this portion of Scripture.
- When fearful thoughts come to taunt you quote Psalm 91 aloud.
- Allow the power of God's Word to encourage you today.

PSALM 91

1. "He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty." It is our responsibility to choose who we will spend our time with during these turbulent times. We can spend our time with the spirit of fear, or we can make a quality decision and spend our time with the Lord. There is protection and provision when we are under the boundary of His shadow.
2. "I will say of the Lord, *"He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust."* Declaring the attributes of the Lord is a powerful, but humble way to address the Lord. And He honors our faith in Him.
3. "Surely He shall deliver you from the snare of the fowler *and* from the perilous pestilence." What encouragement this can stir within us when we vocalize His greatness over our enemy, satan and all of his wicked works.
4. "He shall cover you with His feathers, and under His wings you shall take refuge;
His truth *shall be your* shield and buckler." This Scripture is visually filled with His tenderness towards us, and assures us of His divine protection.
5. "You shall not be afraid of the terror by night, *nor* of the arrow *that* flies by day." With God we do not need to fear what comes against us in the supernatural realm, nor do we need to be afraid of what could rise against us in the physical realm either. God is with us at all times.

6. “Nor of the pestilence *that* walks in darkness, nor of the destruction *that* lays waste at noonday.” He has given us authority over things that can do us harm.
7. “A thousand may fall at your side, and ten thousand at your right hand; *but* it shall not come near you.” Again, we have a boundary of protection as we abide under His shadow.
8. “Only with your eyes shall you look, and see the reward of the wicked.” It is reassuring to know that we will be spared from the consequences of sin.
9. “Because you have made the Lord, *who is* my refuge, *even* the Most High, your dwelling place,” This is confirmation of our security that we have in Him. And no matter what we will face in the days ahead he is our security.
10. “No evil shall befall you, nor shall any plague come near your dwelling;” These are great statements of faith to declare over ourselves verbally every day.
11. “For He shall give His angels charge over you, to keep you in all your ways.” He sends His ministering spirits to protect us from evil.
12. “In *their* hands they shall bear you up, lest you dash your foot against a stone.” The angels have been signed a plan of action on our behalf.
13. “You shall tread upon the lion and the cobra, the young lion and the serpent you shall trample underfoot.” He gives to us authority over all of our enemies.
14. “Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore I will deliver him; I will set him on high, because he has known My name.” This is the reason we can activate the power of His redemption.

15. “He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him; I *will be* with him in trouble;
I will deliver him and honor him.” These words bring assurance to us that no matter what happens in this life, He will respond to our need.
16. “With long life I will satisfy him, and show him My salvation.” These are promised benefits that come from personal relationship with Him.

These are trying times, and we need to take control over a spirit of fear concerning these last days. Praying the Word of God gives strength and peace to our mind and emotions, and changes our focus from fear to His faithful.

1. 7. *Your* days shall be one hundred and twenty years. Genesis 6:3 NKJV

9. Thou shalt come to thy grave in a full age, like as a shock of corn cometh in his season. Job 5:26 KJV

23. Hear, my son, and receive my sayings, and the years of your life will be many. Proverbs 4:10 NKJV

24. My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings. Do not let them depart from your sight; Keep them in the midst of your heart. For they are life to those who find them And health to all their body. Proverbs 4:20-22 NASB
25. The light in the eyes [of him whose heart is joyful] rejoices the hearts of others, and good news nourishes the bones. Proverbs 15:30 AMP
26. Be not wise in your own eyes; reverently fear *and* worship the Lord and turn [entirely] away from evil. It shall be health to your nerves *and* sinews, and marrow *and* moistening to your bones. Proverbs 3:7-8 AMP
27. So then, brace up *and* reinvigorate *and* set right your slackened *and* weakened *and* drooping hands and strengthen your feeble *and* palsied *and* tottering knees, and cut through *and* make firm *and* plain *and* smooth, straight paths for your feet [yes, make them safe and upright and happy paths that go in the right direction], so that the lame *and* halting [limbs] may not be put out of joint, but rather may be cured. (Heb. 12:12- 13). AMP
28. Pleasant words are as a honeycomb, sweet to the mind and healing to the body. Proverbs 16:24 AMP
29. Then the eyes of those who see will not be closed *or* dimmed, and the ears of those who hear will listen. Isaiah 32:3 AMP
30. Then the eyes of the blind will be opened and the ears of the deaf will be unstopped. Isaiah 35:5 NASB
31. Then the lame will leap like a deer, and the tongue of the mute will shout for joy. Isaiah 35:6 NASB
32. But those who wait for the Lord [who expect, look for, and hope in Him] shall change *and* renew their strength *and* power; they shall

lift their wings *and* mount up [close to God] as eagles [mount up to the sun]; they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint *or* become tired. Isaiah 40:31 AMP

33. Fear not [there is nothing to fear], for I am with you; do not look around you in terror *and* be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen *and* harden you to difficulties, yes, I will help you; yes, I will hold you up *and* retain you with My [victorious] right hand of rightness *and* justice. Isaiah 41:10 AMP

34. He gives power to the faint *and* weary, and to him who has no might He increases strength [causing it to multiply and making it to abound]. Isaiah 40:29 AMP

35. I create the fruit of the lips: Peace, peace to *him who is* far off and to *him who is*" Says the Lord, Isaiah 57:19 NKJV

36. 48. (as it is written, "I have made you a father of many nations") in the presence of Him whom he believed—God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did; Romans 4:17 NKJV

49. But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you. Romans 8:11

53. He personally bore our sins in His [own] body on the tree [as on an altar and offered Himself on it], that we might die (cease to exist) to sin and live to righteousness. By His wounds you have been healed. 1 Peter 2:24 AMP

54. And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover." Mark 16:17-18 NKJV

56. And Peter said to him, "Aeneas, Jesus the Christ heals you. Arise and make your bed." Then he arose immediately. Acts 9:34 NKJV

57. Behold, I will bring it health and healing; I will heal them and reveal to them the abundance of peace and truth. Jeremiah 33:6 NKJV
58. "I will seek what was lost and bring back what was driven away, bind up the broken and strengthen what was sick; Ezekiel 34:16 NKJV
59. And it shall be *that* every living thing that moves, wherever the rivers go, will live. There will be a very great multitude of fish, because these waters go there; for they will be healed, and everything will live wherever the river goes. Ezekiel 47:9 NKJV
60. Seek the Lord and live. Amos 5:6 NKJV
61. Then your light shall break forth like the morning, Your healing shall spring forth speedily, and your righteousness shall go before you; the glory of the Lord shall be your rear guard. Isaiah 58:8 NKJV
62. But to you who fear My name the Sun of Righteousness shall arise with healing in His wings; and you shall go out and grow fat like stall-fed calves. Malachi 4:2 NKJV
63. Thus says the Lord God to these bones: "Surely I will cause breath to enter into you, and you shall live. Ezekiel 37:5 NKJV
64. So that even handkerchiefs or aprons were brought from his body to the sick, and the diseases left them and the evil spirits went out of them. Acts 19:12 NKJV
65. For with authority and power He commands the unclean spirits, and they come out." Luke 4:36b NKJV
66. He stood over her and rebuked the fever, and it left her. And immediately she arose and served them. Luke 4:39 NKJV
67. When the sun was setting, all those who had any that were sick with various diseases brought them to Him; and He laid His hands on every one of them and healed them. Luke 4:40 NKJV

68. And it happened when He was in a certain city, that behold, a man who was full of leprosy saw Jesus; and he fell on *his* face and implored Him, saying, "Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean." Then He put out *His* hand and touched him, saying, "I am willing; be cleansed." Immediately the leprosy left him. Luke 5:12-13 NKJV
69. He said to the man who was paralyzed, "I say to you, arise, take up your bed, and go to your house." Luke 5:24 NKJV
70. And a man was there whose right hand was withered....He said to the man, "Stretch out your hand." And he did so, and his hand was restored as whole as the other. Luke 6:6, 10 NKJV
71. And the whole multitude sought to touch Him, for power went out from Him and healed *them* all. Luke 6:19 NKJV
72. But say the word, and my servant will be healed. Luke 7:7 NKJV
73. Then He came and touched the open coffin, and those who carried *him* stood still. And He said, "Young man, I say to you, arise." ¹⁵ So he who was dead sat up and began to speak. And He presented him to his mother. Luke 7:14-15 NKJV
74. For He had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. For it had often seized him, and he was kept under guard, bound with chains and shackles; and he broke the bonds and was driven by the demon into the wilderness....Then they went out to see what had happened, and came to Jesus, and found the man from whom the demons had departed, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed and in his right mind. Luke 8:29, 35 NKJV
75. And He said to her, "Daughter, be of good cheer; your faith has made you well. Go in peace." Luke 8:48 NKJV

76. But He put them all outside, took her by the hand and called, saying, "Little girl, arise." Then her spirit returned, and she arose immediately. Luke 8:54 NKJV
77. And as he was still coming, the demon threw him down and convulsed *him*. Then Jesus rebuked the unclean spirit, healed the child, and gave him back to his father. Luke 9:42 NKJV
78. But when Jesus saw her, He called *her* to *Him* and said to her, "Woman, you are loosed from your infirmity." Luke 13:12 NKJV
79. And behold, there was a certain man before Him who had dropsy... And He took *him* and healed him, and let him go. Luke 14:2, 4 NKJV
80. And they lifted up *their* voices and said, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!" So when He saw *them*, He said to them, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And so it was that as they went, they were cleansed. Luke 17:13-14 NKJV
81. "What do you want Me to do for you?" He said, "Lord, that I may receive my sight." Then Jesus said to him, "Receive your sight; your faith has made you well." Luke 18:41-42 NKJV
82. And one of them struck the servant of the high priest and cut off his right ear. But Jesus answered and said, "Permit even this." And He touched his ear and healed him. Luke 22:50-51 NKJV
83. These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world." John 16:33 NKJV
84. Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit

is, because He makes intercession for the saints according to *the will of God*. And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to *His* purpose. Luke 8:26-28 NKJV

85. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:7 NKJV

86. Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. Hebrews 11:1 NKJV

87. Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Ephesians 6:13 NKJV

88. You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world. 1 John 4:4 NKJV

89. And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and healed their sick. Matthew 14:14 NKJV

90. "The Spirit of the Lord *is* upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to *the* poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to *the* captives And recovery of sight to *the* blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed; To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord." Luke 4:18-19 NKJV

91. "He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses." Matthew 8:17 NKJV

92. Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. Ephesians 6:10 NKJV

93. Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. James 5:14 NKJV
94. And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. James 5:15 NKJV
95. Confess *your* trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much. James 5:16 NKJV
96. And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people. Matthew 4:23 NKJV
97. Let us hold fast the confession of *our* hope without wavering, for He who promised *is* faithful. Hebrews 10:23 NKJV
98. Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you. Luke 10:19 NKJV
99. Jesus Christ *is* the same yesterday, today, and forever. Hebrews 13:8 NKJV
100. But Jesus looked at them and said, "With men *it is* impossible, but not with God; for with God all things are possible." Mark 10:27 NKJV

To help build your faith to believe, to receive and to release His healing power, read and meditate upon these healing scriptures. Read these verses out loud and allow His power to flow from your mouth and heal.

Your Words says, in Romans 10:9-10, “If you confess with your mouth, the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart, that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes to righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.” Father God, I believe in my heart that Jesus Christ is the Son of God. I believe that He died on the cross to save me from my sins, went to hell in my place, rose again three days later, and is alive and

seated at Your right side in heaven. Jesus, forgive me of all my sins. Thank You, for saving me from sin, hell, and myself. I ask You to come into my life to be my Lord and Savior. Thank You for loving me and accepting me just as I am. In Jesus' name I pray, amen.

We need to renounce sickness, disease, and death attacking our bodies. And then we release the healing power of the Holy Spirit and receive it into sick body parts.

Jesus said, "Have faith in God. If you say to this mountain, be removed and cast into the sea, and don't doubt in your heart, but believe the things you say will happen, then you will have whatever you say. So, with a believing heart, declare the promises of God, and receive your miracles. Mk. 11:22-24.

Use the following list of healing confessions and speak them out loud several times a day, just as if you were taking a dose of medicine for yourself or for someone else. Personalize these Scriptures, use your name or the name of a loved one and declare God's healing power.

- By His stripes *you are / I am* healed. Is. 53:5.
- It is the Lord who is healing *you / me*. Ex. 15:26.
- The Lord, *your / my* God is taking sickness away from the midst of *you / me*. Ex. 23:25.
- The Lord will take all sickness away from *you / me*. Deut. 7:15.
- Bless the Lord, who heals all *your / my* diseases. Ps. 103:3.

- Attend to His word because it is life and health to *your / my* flesh. Prov. 4: 20, 22.
- Fear not and don't be dismayed, because the Lord *your / my* God is with *you / me* and will strengthen and help *you / me*. Is. 41:10.
- The Lord says He will restore health to *you / me* and heal *you / me* of *your / my* wounds. Jer. 30:17.
- Jesus cast out the spirit with the word and healed all that were sick. He Himself took *your / my* infirmities and bore *your / my* sicknesses. Matt. 8:16-17.
- Jesus went around healing every sickness and every disease among the people. Matt. 9:35.
- Jesus healed the lame, blind, maimed, and many others, and He is healing *you / me*, for which *we / I* glorify God, as the multitudes did. Matt. 15: 30-31.
- These signs will follow *you / me* because *you / I* believe. *You / I* will lay hands on *yourself / myself* and others and *you / I* will recover. Mk. 16:17-18.
- Jesus gave *you / me*, as His disciple power over all devils, to cure diseases, and to heal the sick. Lk. 9: 1-2.
- Jesus told us to heal the sick, so in obedience to Him, and in His name, *we / I* believe that *you are / I am* being healed, and know that the kingdom of God has come near *you / me*. Luke 10:9.
- The Lord is granting *you / me* boldness to speak His word. He is stretching forth His hand to heal *you / me* in the name of Jesus. Acts 4:29-30.

- Jesus healed all of the sick people, and those troubled with unclean spirits that were brought to Him. So, *we / I bring you / myself* to Him, and He is healing *you / me*. Acts 5:16.
- God anointed Jesus with the Holy Spirit and with power. He went about doing good and healing all those oppressed by the devil, including *you / me*. Acts 10:38.
- God will keep *you / me* in perfect peace because *your / my* mind is fixed on Him and *you / I* trust in Him. Is. 26:3.
- *You / I* shall not die, but live, and declare the work of the Lord. Ps. 118:17.

But joy comes in the morning. Psalm 30:5.
29. *But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control.* Against such there is no law. Galatians 5:22-23.
30. But let all those rejoice who put their trust in You; *let them ever shout for joy, because You defend them*; let those also who love Your name be joyful in You. Psalm 5:11.
31. *A merry heart does good, like medicine*, but a broken spirit dries the bones. Proverbs 17:22

These 30 love scriptures are designed to teach you how to love God, others, and yourself. Imagine the impact we can make if we will put these into practice on a daily basis.

1. Love Gives: *"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life."* John 3:16.
2. How to Love God: *"And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment."* Mark 12:30.
3. The Reason We Can Love God: *"We love Him, because He first loved us."* 1 John 4: 19.
4. God is Love: *"Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love."* 1 John 4:8.
5. God's Type of Love: *"The LORD passed in front of Moses, calling out, 'Yahweh! The LORD! The God of compassion and mercy! I am slow to anger and filled with unfailing love and faithfulness.'" Exodus 34:6.*
6. How to Love Others: *"And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these."* Mark 12:31.
7. What Love Does Not Do to Others: *"Love does no harm to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfillment of the law."* Romans 13:10.
8. How Husbands Are to Love their Wives: *"Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her."* Ephesians 5:25.
9. How Wives Are to Love their Husbands: *"Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself, and the wife see that she reverence her husband."* Ephesians 5:33.

10. How to Love Your Enemies: *"But love your enemies, do good, and lend, hoping for nothing in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High. For He is kind to the unthankful and evil."* Luke 6:35.
11. Love Forgives: *"In accordance with your great love, forgive the sin of these people, just as you have pardoned them from the time they left Egypt until now."* Numbers 14:19.
12. Love is Sincere: *"Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor that which is evil. Cling to that which is good."* Romans 12:9.
13. Love Bears One Another: *"With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love."* Ephesians 4:2.
14. Love is Fearless: *"There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love."* 1 John 4: 18.
15. Christians Love One Another: *"Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God."* 1 John 4:7.
16. When Do We Love? : *"A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for adversity."* Proverbs 17:17.
17. You Love With Your Actions: *"By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down our lives for the brethren. But whoever has this world's goods, and sees his brother in need, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him? My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, but in deed and in truth."* 1 John 3:16-18.
18. The Attributes of Love: *"Love suffers long and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; does not behave*

rudely, does not seek its own, is not provoked, thinks no evil; does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things."¹

Corinthians 13:4-7.

19. What Love Cannot Do: *"Love never fails. But whether there are prophecies, they will fail; whether there are tongues, they will cease; whether there is knowledge, it will vanish away."*¹ Corinthians 13:8.
20. What I Sound Like Without Love: *"Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal."*¹ Corinthians 13:1.
21. The Worth of Spiritual Gifts Without Love: *"And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing."*¹ Corinthians 13:2.
22. What I Gain by Acts of Charity Without Love: *"And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, but have not love, it profits me nothing."*¹ Corinthians 13:3.
23. How We Should Do Things: *"Let all that you do be done with love."*¹ Corinthians 16:14.
24. What You Should Always Keep With You: *"Let love and faithfulness never leave you; bind them around your neck, write them on the tablet of your heart. Then you will win favor and a good name in the sight of God and man."* Proverbs 3:3-4.
25. What We Can Rely On: *"And so we know and rely on the love God has for us. God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in them."*¹ John 4:16.

26. How We Are to Be Rooted and Established: *"I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love."*
Ephesians 3:16-17.
27. Love's Greatest Expression: *"Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends."* John 15:13.
28. We Owe One Another this One Thing: *"Owe no one anything except to love one another, for he who loves another has fulfilled the law."*
Romans 13:8.
29. What God Lavishes Upon Us: *"Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God! Therefore the world does not know us, because it did not know Him."* 1 John 3:1.
30. A Love Prayer for You: *"May the Lord make your love increase and overflow for each other and for everyone else, just as ours does for you."* 1 Thessalonians 3:12.

Have you ever heard anyone say that someone's anxiety, fear and worry are just in their head? In reality these are more than just mere thoughts, feelings, and imaginations gone wild. Anxiety, fear and worry are spiritual weapons used by the devil to destroy us. And they do start in the mind, as the enemy whispers fearful lies into people's spiritual ears. This is why it is of utmost importance that we pay attention to what we are thinking about. What is feeding our thoughts? The Spirit of the Lord warns us in 2 Corinthians 10:3-6 through Paul, *"For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal*

but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ, and being ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled." We are to take every thought into captivity, we are to think about what we are thinking about. Be on the alert for doubt-filled thoughts that go against God and His Word.

2 Corinthians 2:7 reveals to us what fear really is. *"For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind."* God's Word tells us that fear is a supernatural being, it is a spirit, an evil spirit.

And He has given us authority over such beings and their supernatural activities, *"Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you."*; Luke 10:19.

And 1 John 4:18 reminds us of the supernatural power of perfect love over fear, *"There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love."*

But as stated earlier, we have to take every thought into captivity. We need to exercise Christ's authority in us over our thoughts of fear. In order to do so we need to accept the advice from Philippians 4:8-9, *"Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things. The things which you learned and*

received and heard and saw in me, these do, and the God of peace will be with you.” We are to capture fearful, negative, ugly thoughts and bind them up with the Word of God. Renew our minds with God’s promises, “And do not be conformed to this age, but be transformed by the renewing of the mind, for you to prove what is the good and well-pleasing and perfect will of God.”; Romans 12:2.

Free yourself from worry about your daily needs. God is both able and willing to fulfill these needs for you, Matthew 6:25-34 reads as follows, “*That is why I tell you not to worry about everyday life—whether you have enough food and drink, or enough clothes to wear. Isn’t life more than food, and your body more than clothing? Look at the birds. They don’t plant or harvest or store food in barns, for your heavenly Father feeds them. And aren’t you far more valuable to him than they are? Can all your worries add a single moment to your life?*

“And why worry about your clothing? Look at the lilies of the field and how they grow. They don’t work or make their clothing, yet Solomon in all his glory was not dressed as beautifully as they are. And if God cares so wonderfully for wildflowers that are here today and thrown into the fire tomorrow, he will certainly care for you. Why do you have so little faith?

“So don’t worry about these things, saying, ‘What will we eat? What will we drink? What will we wear?’ These things dominate the thoughts of unbelievers, but your heavenly Father already knows all your needs. Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give

you everything you need. "So don't worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will bring its own worries. Today's trouble is enough for today."

With the redemptive power of the Lord overcome the fear of death.

Hebrews 2:14-15 explains why we can be free from this fear, *"Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; and deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage."* And in Psalm 23:4 we are comforted by these well-known words, *"Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me."*

God's Word has this to say about the fear of evil people in these last days in Matthew 10:28, *"And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell."* We need to keep this is the forefront of our minds during these uncertain times that our Lord Jesus Christ is greater than our enemy, satan. And in 1 Peter 3:13-14, *"And who is he who will harm you if you become followers of what is good? But even if you should suffer for righteousness' sake, you are blessed. "And do not be afraid of their threats, nor be troubled."* Psalm 118:6 promises us that, *"The Lord is on my side; I will not fear. What can man do to me?"* Deuteronomy 31:6 encourages us with these famous words, *"Be strong and of good courage, do not fear nor be afraid of them; for the Lord your God, He is the One who goes with you. He will not leave you nor forsake you."*

And here are more Scriptures to meditate upon to overcome anxiety, fear, and worry.

- For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father." Romans 8:15.
- Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee. So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me. Hebrews 13:5-6.
- Fear not, for I *am* with you; be not dismayed, for I *am* your God. I will strengthen you, yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.' Isaiah 41:10.
- For I, the Lord your God, will hold your right hand, saying to you, 'Fear not, I will help you.' Isaiah 41:13.
- Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid. John 14:27.
- Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the Lord your God *is* with you wherever you go." Joshua 1:9.
- Whenever I am afraid, I will trust in You. Psalm 56:3.
- Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. Philippians 5:6-7.

- In the multitude of my anxieties within me, your comforts delight my soul. Psalm 94:19.
- Cast your burden upon the Lord and He will sustain you; He will never allow the righteous to be shaken. Psalm 55:22.
- Say to those *who are* fearful-hearted, "Be strong, do not fear! Behold, your God will come *with* vengeance, *With* the recompense of God; He will come and save you." Isaiah 35:4.
- The fear of man brings a snare, but whoever trusts in the Lord shall be safe. Proverbs 29:25.
- When you lie down, you will not be afraid; Yes, you will lie down and your sleep will be sweet. Proverbs 3:24.
- The angel of the Lord encamps all around those who fear Him, and delivers them. Psalm 34:7.
- I sought the Lord, and He heard me, and delivered me from all my fears. Psalm 34:4.
- As soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, He said to the ruler of the synagogue, "Do not be afraid; only believe." Mark 5:36.

Many people are suffering from daily stress and strife, and this too effects the physical body and can make one sick. Let's fill our minds with the peace of God, and allow His healing words to transform the condition of our physical bodies. Be at peace today.

Read and ponder upon these 31 Scriptures about God's peace for us.

1. But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, Galatians 5:22.
2. And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful. Colossians 3:15.
3. I will both lie down in peace, and sleep; for You alone, O Lord, make me dwell in safety. Psalm 4:8.
4. I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called, with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. Ephesians 4:1-3.
5. Mark the blameless *man*, and observe the upright; for the future of *that man is peace*. Psalm 37:37.
6. But if the unbeliever departs, let him depart; a brother or a sister is not under bondage in such *cases*. But God has called us to peace. 1 Corinthians 7:15.
7. Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. Philipians 4:6-7.

8. If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men. Romans 12:18.
9. The Lord will give strength to His people; the Lord will bless His people with peace. Psalm 29:11.
10. Now the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace. James 3:18.
11. Pursue peace with all *people*, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord: Hebrews 12:14.
12. Deceit is in the heart of those who devise evil, but counselors of peace have joy. Proverbs 12:20.
13. When a man's ways please the Lord, He makes even his enemies to be at peace with him. Proverbs 16:7.
14. Depart from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it. Psalm 34:14.
15. Mercy, peace, and love be multiplied to you. Jude 1:2.
16. not returning evil for evil or reviling for reviling, but on the contrary blessing, knowing that you were called to this, that you may inherit a blessing. For "He who would love life And see good days, Let him refrain his tongue from evil, And his lips from speaking deceit. Let him turn away from evil and do good; Let him seek peace and pursue it. 1 Peter 3:9-11.
17. You will keep *him* in perfect peace, *whose mind is stayed on You*, because he trusts in You. Isaiah 26:3.
18. Great peace have those who love Your law, and nothing causes them to stumble. Psalm 119:165.

19. "For you shall go out with joy, and be led out with peace; the mountains and the hills shall break forth into singing before you, and all the trees of the field shall clap *their* hands. Isaiah 55:12.
20. These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world." John 16:33.
21. Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid. John 14:27.
22. How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him who brings good news, who proclaims peace, who brings glad tidings of good *things*, who proclaims salvation, who says to Zion, "Your God reigns!" Isaiah 52:7.

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. John 3:16.

But [in fact] He has borne our griefs, and He has carried our sorrows *and* pains; yet we [ignorantly] assumed that He was stricken, struck down by God and degraded *and* humiliated [by Him]. But He was wounded for our

transgressions, He was crushed for our wickedness [our sin, our injustice, our wrongdoing]; the punishment [required] for our well-being *fell* on Him, and by His stripes (wounds) we are healed. Isaiah 53:4-5.

Therefore, if anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. 2 Corinthians 5:17.

The Lord your God in your midst, the Mighty One, will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet *you* with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing." Zephaniah 3:17.

But those who wait on the Lord shall renew *their* strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint. Isaiah 40:31.

Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the Lord your God *is* with you wherever you go." Joshua 1:9.

Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him,

And He shall direct your paths. Proverbs 3:5-6.

Cast your burden on the Lord, and He shall sustain you; He shall never permit the righteous to be moved. Psalm 55:22.

And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to *His* purpose. Romans 8:28.

What then shall we say to these things? If God *is* for us, who *can be* against us? Romans 8:31.

For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 8:38-39.

And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back again and I will take you to Myself, so that where I am you may be also. John 14:3.

As far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us. Psalm 103:12.

Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; for You *are* with me;

Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me. Psalm 23:4.
